## EV Charging Points

As part of our mission to become a truly sustainable company, Wedge Group Galvanizing has implemented additional EV charging points across their 16 UK sites.

To enhance our existing sustainability credentials, we have invested over £350,000 to introduce almost 50 EV chargers across the business.

Managing Director, Chris Woolridge, said: "We've increased our EV charging facilities across our entire Group, adding 50 EV chargers to our business for employees to use."

Each of their 16 locations (including 14 plants, their Head Office in Willenhall, and Hasco-Thermic Ltd), have been installed with between two and four chargers for their staff members with company cars to utilise.

This advancement is totally aligned with our company-wide 'Sustainability Commitment', which focuses on our triple bottom line: our profits, our people, and our planet.

We're passionate about supporting our team with their personal environmental goals and in driving forward our journey to becoming a net zero organisation.

"That said, it was essential that this development was (and will remain) a viable and suitable solution for our staff too, and so the tariff is currently capped at a level which is much cheaper than public charging.

It's a service that we hope to roll out to our wider team as they also embark on adopting electric vehicles ahead of the current 2040 legislation deadline."
